WCS is implementing its Sustainable Agricultural programs in many Indian States, where in it is assisting the poor farmers in reducing the cost of cultivation clubbed with increasing the cumulative income thru livelihood and skill enhancement initiatives and market linkages by forming FPOs and Farmer Groups at village levels.

WCS is also focusing on reducing their expenditure on costly harmful chemical-based farm inputs by providing natural alternatives such as Compost, FYM, Liquid Fertilizes, Bio pesticides etc. Thus, playing an important role in environment protection by conserving soil nutrition.

WCS is instrumental in setting up of BCI (Better Cotton Initiatives - Netherlands) programs in various states of India, benefitting more than 3 lakh cotton farmers on a cumulative basis. Most of the project farmers were linked with the ginners for farm gate procurement, which resulted in substantial cost saving and fetched premium prices for their produce.

Undertook Organic Farming training for the farmers in Ghana, Africa, focusing on use of Organic Inputs, Certifications, Natural Pesticides, etc.

Implementing PPP IAD Programs on Millets and PPP IHD Programs on Chilli in association with Govt. of Karnataka benefiting around 5000 farmers. In addition to value addition on quality of the produce, WCS has also facilitated direct market linkage for all the farmers, which resulted in good returns for the farmers.

We are conducting the evaluating studies on the impact of Fairtrade sugar certification to date within Fairtrade producer organizations that has held certification for more than three years.

Working with Solidaridad in their Sustainable Sugarcane Initiative in Karnataka, in partnership with Shree Renuka Sugars Ltd. and supported by Coca Cola Foundation to promote good agronomical and climate smart agriculture (CSA) in sugarcane farming.
